The Parent Portal system gives parents access to homework assignments, student progress and school information. This system will be used at the elementary school level in the future. Class size adjustment is ongoing. A kindergarten classroom was added at Loma Vista and there is a possibility that a 6 th grade classroom may have to be added. Classes are being balanced district wide.
