PUBLIC COMMENTS

Pursuant to Education Code section 33050 et seq., the District received a waiver from the California Department of Education allowing it to forgo the traditional competitive bidding procedure typically used when leasing school district surplus property. Instead, the waiver granted the District permission to use an alternative request for proposal ("RFP") procedure in which the District solicits offers from interested parties for the lease of the Property. The RFP will set out the guidelines and minimum requirements for the lease of a designated portion of the Property. The District will then assess all proposals and negotiate with the proposers to determine the best options for the District. The District's Board of Trustees will review the proposals received, as well as staff recommendations related to such proposals, in order to determine if a lease agreement can be reached that is in the best interest of the District.
